

Westnet merges with Mambourin

Mambourin and Westnet are community organisations which provide services to adults with disabilities in the western region of Melbourne.

Last night, the Westnet community held a Special General Meeting, at which the Westnet Members voted to voluntarily wind up and transfer their assets to Mambourin, which means that Westnet and Mambourin immediately commence as a merged organisation.

“This is very exciting news”, said Rohan Braddy, Mambourin’s Chief Executive Officer. “We firmly believe that this is an opportunity to build this new, merged entity into something truly wonderful for, and with, the people that we support and their families,” Mr Braddy said.

These two strong disability organisations merging will create an even stronger entity, and benefits of the merger include:

- opportunities to further improve the quality of services;
- more choice for the people who use the services;
- developing individualised support services;
- improved career opportunities for staff including broadening skills, capability and qualifications; and
- greater efficiencies allowing more money to be spent on direct client programs.

“We would like to thank most sincerely the members of Westnet who have trusted us with the future of their great organisation,” Mr Braddy said. “It will be extremely empowering to the people we support,” he added.
