Re: Coronavirus – flexi-choices and WAM

Some parents and carers have asked whether the coronavirus will impact upon our ability to get out into the community with our flexi-choices and WAM programs.

The health and wellbeing of our community members is our top priority and we will be closely monitoring all health advice issued by the Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS).

Today the DHHS released the following statement:

*At the present time, because there is no evidence of transmission in the community in Victoria, you should continue to go about your daily life and travel and work or study as normal. This includes continuing to use public transport, cars, taxis, hire cars, ridesharing, cycling or walking in public places.*

Based on this we will continue to run all activities as usual. We will ensure that everyone practices good hand hygiene when out and about in the community.
