Dear Mambourin Community Member,

Yesterday the State Government announced the gradual easing of Stage 3 restrictions. I'd like to provide you with an update on what this means for Mambourin and the services we can provide our community.

Unfortunately, we do not yet have any information from the Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS) regarding when we can re-open our Community Hubs. However, the announcement does mean we have more flexibility in the supports we are permitted to provide.

We will continue to offer 1:1 essential community supports (such as shopping, exercise, attending medical appointments), in-home supports and online programs. We can now also extend this to include outdoor exercise and recreational activities in the community in small groups. These activities will be undertaken with appropriate social distancing and might include things like exercise in local or national parks, or walking along the beach. These activities will commence from Monday 18 May.

A member of our team will contact you to discuss your current support needs over the next week. However, if you would like to take up the option for recreational supports in a small group, please get in touch on: 9731 9200 or by contacting your local hub manager as soon as possible.

While we are all eager to return to business as usual at our Community Hubs, I'm sure you'd appreciate that doing this in the safest way possible is our top priority. We are currently in the process of planning a staged return to full services which we'll roll out as government restrictions ease. We will keep you updated as we enact each stage.
