Re: Return to services

We are celebrating the fantastic news that the snap lockdown will end as scheduled at 11.59pm tonight, Wednesday 17 February.

This means that all Mambourin services including group activities at Community Hubs and WAM (Weekends at Mambourin) can resume from tomorrow, Thursday 18 February. We will continue to follow infection control procedures and meet density requirements to ensure the health and safety of our community.

The lockdown served as a good reminder that we are not totally free of the virus just yet, and that we need to keep working together to keep everyone safe. Please do not attend Mambourin services if you are feeling unwell, are awaiting test results or you have visited any of the known public exposure sites in Victoria or interstate.
