Dear Mambourin Community Member,

Re: Reminder to let us know if you receive your COVID-19 or Flu vaccine

On 18 March I wrote to you about the rollout of Phase 1b of the Australian Government's COVID-19 Vaccination Program. Several of our community members have already reported that they have received the vaccine – which is great to hear!

While you are not under any obligation to provide us details regarding your vaccination status, we strongly encourage you to inform your local hub manager when you have received your COVID-19 and/or Flu vaccine. This will enable us to keep a confidential list of who has the vaccine in the event of a suspected infection at Mambourin or in the community.

If you haven't booked to get your COVID-19 vaccine yet, you can use the online eligibility checker to make an appointment with a registered GP or healthcare provider. You can access it here: covid-vaccine.healthdirect.gov.au/eligibility.

Getting these vaccines is voluntary. While we encourage those who can to get these vaccines, it is important to stress that Mambourin will not be mandating either vaccine for customers. People who choose not to receive these vaccines will not be treated any differently.
