We are celebrating the great news that the snap lockdown will end as scheduled at 11.59 pm tonight, Tuesday 27 July.

This means that group activities at our community hubs will run from tomorrow, Wednesday 28 July, according to density requirements. Our hub teams will contact you today about arrangements.

Our WAM (Weekends at Mambourin) can also resume where allowable within restrictions. If you attend WAM or Flexi-Choices, one of our Flexi Choices Coordinators will be in touch to discuss your options.

We will continue to follow infection control procedures, meet density requirements, and monitor exposure sites to ensure the health and safety of our community.
