Dear Mambourin Community Member

Re: COVID-19 update

The Victorian Government eased most COVID-19 isolation requirements on Wednesday 12 October.

However, some restrictions remain in place for disability service providers and health settings. Mambourin will continue to follow Western Public Health Unit (WPHU) recommendations to ensure that our hubs remain a safe environment for our staff and community members.

Below is a brief overview of what the changes will mean for your services at Mambourin.

If you test positive for COVID-19 or have symptoms

Anyone who has COVID-19 or symptoms of COVID-19 should continue to notify Mambourin and not attend services for seven days. However, we will no longer report occurrences of positive cases to the wider Mambourin community.

Face masks

Masks are still recommended for all customer-facing staff and volunteers. Customers who are comfortable and able to wear masks are encouraged to continue to do so, especially in high-risk settings such as on public transport or crowded venues.

Infection control

We will continue to use strict infection control procedures and COVID-19 prevention measures. To keep our hubs as safe as possible, we ask that you do not attend if you have any symptoms of COVID-19 or cold and flu.
