Dear Mambourin Community Member,

**Re: COVID-19 update**

You may be aware that the number of active COVID cases in Victoria has significantly increased in the last week, with experts suggesting we are facing a new wave of COVID infections. We have also seen an increase in new cases across the Mambourin community.

To ensure the health and safety of everyone at Mambourin, all staff, volunteers and visitors will be required to wear a mask. Community members who are comfortable and able to wear masks are also encouraged to do so.

We urge you to stay vigilant and follow COVID-safe practices such as:

- maintaining social distance
- avoiding physical greetings such as handshakes
- taking extra care on public transport and in crowded venues
- practising good hand hygiene
- taking a test and staying at home if you have any cold or flu symptoms.

To keep our hubs as safe as possible, it is especially important that you do not attend if you are unwell, even if you have tested negative for COVID-19.

We are still available to support you to book or attend a vaccination clinic appointment. Please speak to a member of your local hub team to organise this.
